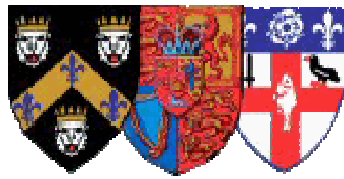


Hoping to train with the oldest rugby club in the world?
